

# Stencil Vinyl

## 2020 INSTRUCTIONS

**Suggested Surfaces:** Fence Board, Sugar Mold, Panel Board, Rustic Shiplap, Rustic Board, Slatted Block



- Step 1:** Sand the front of your surface with your sanding block until it is smooth. If preferred, paint the surface base with your chosen paint color. Let it dry.
- Step 2:** Take the backing off of your stencil vinyl. Place the vinyl in the desired location on the surface. Use a scraper card to ensure that the stencil is adhered well to the surface. Peel back the transfer tape.
- Step 3:** Apply a light coat of the LE Sealer to the stencil design and let it dry.
- Step 4:** Once dry, lightly paint your chosen paint color over the stencil design. When the first coat of paint is dry, paint a second coat.
- Step 5:** Once both layers of paint are dry, slowly peel up the stencil vinyl. Use a small tool (tweezers, exacto knife, etc.) to pick out any excess pieces of vinyl left behind.

*\*For multiple color designs, do the base/bottom layer first. Repeat steps 2-5 for all layers.*
