# June Craft Club Box Project Instructions

There's no better time than summertime! We are excited to celebrate with the adorable projects included in this month's box. First up, you get to create this fun and festive firecracker block set to celebrate the 4th of July! It's trendy, and extra cute too. Additionally, we thought it would be fun to stay refreshed this summer using the summer vibes water bottle. And how about this oh-so-fun table runner for your summer cookouts? Feel free to cut out the graphics and place them wherever you like most. This is sure to add the perfect touch!

## Table Runner

1. Preheat iron on cotton setting (250-300 degrees)
2. Iron your table runner to remove wrinkles
3. Cut apart your graphics and determine where you would like them on your table runner
4. Peel the transfer film off of the design, and lay your vinyl graphics on the table runner.
5. Iron over the vinyl for 45 to 60 seconds. Let it cool completely before lifting the clear transfer film
6. If your vinyl is not fully secured, place the film over the design for an additional minute. Cool completely
7. SLOWLY remove the transfer film, ensuring that the vinyl is fully adhered to the fabric

## Water Bottle

1. Apply vinyl to the surface
2. Use your scraper card to secure the vinyl to the water bottle & remove transfer tape

## Firecracker Blocks

1. Start by painting your blocks. Start with the sides, and then work your way to the front until you have evenly covered your blocks. Allow to dry.
2. Apply poly to your blocks.
3. Once your blocks have completely dried, lay your vinyl. Remove the backing paper, center the design to your liking, and then firmly rub it onto the surface using your scraper card. Remove the transfer tape slowly, checking to make sure the design is staying in place on the blocks.
4. Cut apart your twine and attach to the upper back side of your blocks using glue. Make sure the twine sticks up off of the block mimicking a firecracker wick.
