

Step 6: Start on either side and start peeling the Layers apart.

Because you have a piece of painters tape vertically in the middle of your sign, you have two sections. You can start on either side. Picking one side, carefully peel the backing paper from the transfer tape. Avoid touching the actual lettering of the saying itself. The saying should stay on the transfer tape, with the backing paper left bare.

Step 7: Cut the backing paper off.

Once you have the transfer tape and saying off of the backing paper, cut the backing paper off near the painters tape. Don't remove the painters tape yet! Let the backing paper fall to the floor.

Step 8: Lay the transfer tape and saying of the one side on the wall.

Hold the transfer tape & saying as close to the wall as possible to avoid any wrinkles or bubbles. With the scraper, scrape from the tape to the outside of the lettering. This will lay the saying onto the wall.

Step 9: REMOVE THE BLUE PAINTERS TAPE

Step 10: Repeat steps 6-8 to the other side of the saying.

Step 11: Gently scrape over the entire saying; use wet sponge if necessary

Using your scraper, firmly rub the entire saying, paying extra attention to the edges of each letter. This is adhering the saying to the wall. (Do not rub the boarder around your saying~ this is going to be removed in the next step). Usually just rubbing the letters firmly with the scraper card will do the trick, but if you are having problems, moisten the transfer tape with a wet sponge. After a few seconds it will start to wrinkle. When this happens, rub it again with your scraper card. (*Be careful not to get water outside the edges of the tape as it may seep under your saying and weaken the adhesive.)

Step 12: Remove Transfer Tape

Slowly peel the transfer tape from the wall. Be sure that the dots of "i"'s, and other small pieces don't get pulled off with the transfer tape.

Tip: Peel the tape straight back, so it is as close to the wall as possible, and not "out".

After you removed the transfer tape, **carefully remove the boarder that is around your saying. If you have a symbol off to the side, leave that since you will need it for the next step in laying the 2nd layer.

Step 13: Lay additional layer (IF APPLICABLE)

If your order contains two layers, this is when you will be laying your second layer.

You will have noticed that each of your layers came with a symbol in one of the corners. You simply have to line up the top layer symbol with the one that is already on the wall.

After you have lined up the symbols and everything is level, repeat steps 4-12.

Step 13: ENJOY YOUR NEW SAYING!

Removing Wall Lettering

(Please note you can't reuse after you remove)

**When you wish to remove lettering, use heat (such as a blow dryer) and rubbing alcohol.

1. Apply heat source over lettering for a few seconds and then pull letters away from wall.
2. If and residue is left, use rubbing alcohol to wipe.

****Same directions apply when applying vinyl to any other smooth surface. ****
